CLERGY VISIT PROTOCOL

Expectations When Visiting:

- Visitation Hours: Daily from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Cell phone must be locked in car.
- Car windows must be up.
- Push front buzzer [Have I.D.].
- Security Check: Portal/Wand.
- Let Lobby Officer know you are here to visit an inmate. Provide the name of the inmate.
- Show Lobby Officer your Pastoral credential (i.e., License, Ordination or Certificate).
- You are permitted to take into the Attorney Client Room (ACR) a Sacred text (Bible, Quran, Talmud, etc.), Notepad, and Pen.
- You are permitted one half hour visit (30 minutes).
- Make no favors or promises.
- Do not give or receive anything.
- Materials for inmates must be provided to the Chaplain for approval.
- Please refrain from any physical contact with the inmate (IAW: Prison Rape Elimination Act).
- Inmate is never to leave ACR without Correctional Officer (C.O.) present.
- You are not to leave without a C.O. present.
- Always sit closest to the door.
- Use the phone on wall if you need to call control, Ext. 3114.

NOTE: Clergy visit not permitted if related to the Inmate, even if in – law. If not sure or have questions, please ask the C.O.

Other Helpful Tips:

- 1. Follow all polices of the facility.
- 2. Show respect to all employees of the facility with the realization of being subject to the Correctional Officers (CO) on duty.
- 3. Refrain from defaming other religions.
- 4. Be careful not to be insensitive to needs of inmates.
- 5. Exercise caution to not berate or degrade an inmate or embarrass an inmate.
- 6. Do not promise the inmates that you will contact their families for them.
